She holds a USEF R-rated judging license and has judged some of the most prestigious shows in the country, including the Devon Horse Show, the Hampton Classic, the USEF Pony Finals and the Platinum Performance / USEF Show Jumping Talent Search East Coast Finals. Karen is also the Chairperson for the USHJA Equitation Task Force, a member of the USHJA Hunter Task Force, the USEF Developing Riders Committee, and the USHJA Trainer's Committee for Trainer Certification.

Karen attacks her mission to teach, judge, or give a clinic with the same enthusiasm that began building her reputation more than a half-century ago.
